GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)
PRIVACY POLICY



What data will be collected

Accrington Road Runners (The Club) is committed to protecting and respecting members privacy. In order to become a member the Club will need to collect certain information which will include name, date of birth, gender, address, telephone number and email address. These details will be shared with England Athletics in order to register the member.

All the personal data the club collects from members will be collected, stored and processed in accordance with :-

- England Athletics and UK Athletics guidelines;
- Current GDPR

Use of the data

- For England Athletics registration purposes;
- Sharing data with Sporting Secretary for entering events and with league and other competition organisers for entry into events;
- Notifying members of Club related news and any important issues that would impact upon the Club or individual members;
- MemberMojo for new membership applications and membership renewals;
- By Sporting Secretary to register runners to take part in external or internal competition.

Sharing data with third parties

- MemberMojo the Uk based hosting service used for new membership applications and renewals;
- Other than England Athletics and MemberMojo, the Club will not sell, distribute or lease personal data to third parties.

How long will we keep your data

- The Club will retain members data for length of membership. Data will be deleted within 24 months of membership lapsing;
- MemberMojo will hold data for the duration of membership and for 24 months following membership expiry for members to log in and renew if they wish.

Members' rights

Members have the following rights under data protection legislation ;

- to access a copy of the data the club holds in relation to them;
- to have inaccurate personal data rectified.

Accrington Road Runners use of social media

There is a private FaceBook group set up in the name of Accrington Road Runners which is only accessible to club members. These pages are regulated by members of the committee to ensure that connects are both appropriate and that the pages are in compliance with GDPR.
